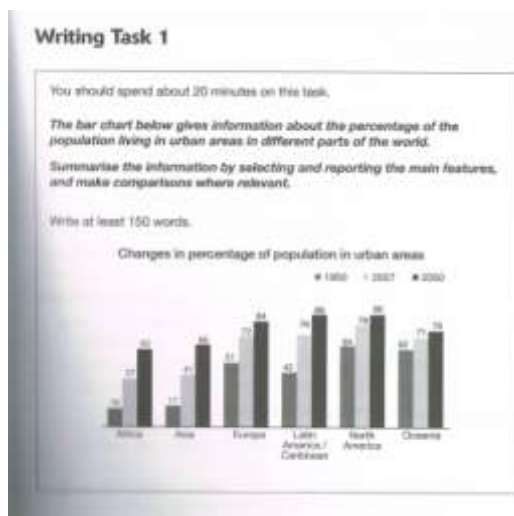


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The bar chart shows ~~the~~ a comparison of the ratio of the number of the people who live in urban areas in six parts of the world in three times 1950, 2007, and 2050.

One of the most striking features is ~~that the amount of~~ the huge increased ~~in the~~ percentage during the 100 years. The percentage of population living in cities in Asia is expected to increase the most from 17 to 66 percent in the 100 years.

The percentage of population in urban areas in Africa and Latin America ~~and the~~ Caribbean will increase from 15 and 42 to 62 and 89 respectively. On the other hand, in Oceania the percentage ~~of that~~ will increase from 62 to 76, which is the smallest increase in this period.

Second, North America ~~keeps~~ it is predicted to have the highest ratio of population in urban areas by 2050. In 1950, North America, Oceania, and Europe were the three most urbanized areas with 64, 62, and 51% respectively, whereas in 2050 Latin America/Caribbean will be the second urbanized area overtaking Oceania and Europe.

**Comment [z3]:** Second? What is first? is it "one of the most striking features"? This is too far back. Also, this is just not a good way to sequence your ideas.

**Comment [z4]:** This is vital; you have to show the examiner that you realise there is some kind of prediction involved here, and that's these numbers have not already been achieved
